However, we think the part in which it concerns people and the impact on our lives and society is underexplored and deserves attention. We state that technology itself is not the pressing problem in the world, but rather the integration of it. In envisioning a future we are not utopians, but realists.

Because of this unique combination, we are experts in the integration of digital technology in society and across a wide range of disciplines and knowledge areas.
