

Entry requirements for applicants with an international diploma

We require evidence that your previous education is equal to the level of a Dutch VWO diploma. Some of the diploma's that are sufficient:

	International Baccalaureate
Austria:	Reifezeugnis / Reifeprüfungszeugnis
Canada:	Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) with 6 university preparation courses of Ontario Academic Courses (OACs)
Denmark:	Studentereksamenbevis (STX) / Bevis for Højere Forberedelseseksamen (HF)
Estonia:	Gümnaasiumi lõputunnistus
Finland:	Ylioppilastutkintotodistus / Studentexamenbevis/ Matriculation Examination Certificate
France:	Baccalauréat Général
Germany:	Zeugnis der Allgemeinen Hochschulreife
Ireland:	Leaving Certificate (min. 6 subjects with a min of 2 on higher level graded A,B or C)
Italy:	Diploma di Superamento dell'Esame di Stato Conclusivo dei Corsi di Istruzione Secondario Superiore (awarded by a liceo classico / scientifico / linguistico / scienze umane)
Letland:	Atestāts par vispārējo vidējo izglītību
Lithuania:	Brandos Atestatas
UK:	General Certificate of Secondary Education in 3 subjects graded A*, A, B or C + General Certificate of Education with 3 subjects in advanced level (in 6 different subjects)
Switzerland:	Maturity Certificate / Maturitätszeugnis / Maturitätsausweis / Certificat de Maturité

Please keep in mind that only after thorough verification and evaluation of documents we can decide on your previous education.

Language requirements

Proficiency in English is an admission requirement for ESP. You will need to submit proof of proficiency in English as part of the application process.

ESP accepts the following English tests:

IELTS (6.5), **TOEFL** (Paper 570, Computer 230, iBT 90), or **Cambridge ESOL** (CAE A or B+) or CPE scores A, B or C.

Exemptions

If your previous education is from USA, UK, Ireland, Australia, New Zealand and in some cases Canada then your previous education is 100% in English and that is sufficient language proficiency.

If your previous education is bilingual (including English) you might get exemption from the language test. We will send your file to our exam board and they can grant you exemption.
