MODULES






- ▶ Module 1 - Applying occupational therapy and occupational science research and theory to practice (UK)
- ▶ Module 2 - Qualitative research in relation to human occupation - critical reflections on methods and researcher positionality (NL)
- ▶ Module 3 - Applying and reflecting on quantitative research methods in relation to human occupation (CH)
- ▶ Module 4 - Socio-cultural perspectives of human occupation - Scientific and theoretical argumentation (ESP)
- ▶ Module 5 - Designing and planning a research project in relation to human occupation (SWE)
- ▶ Module 6 - Conducting a research project in relation to human occupation

STUDY LOAD

For modules 1 to 4:

- ▶ Preparatory work: 56 hours over two weeks, in the home country
- ▶ Classwork: 80 hours over two weeks, at hosting institutions
- ▶ Assignment: 200 hours over 8 weeks, in the home country

Modules 5 and 6 have a different structure with more self-study and online support, leading to a research thesis.
