

General conditions authorisation payment of tuition fees

The tuition fee amount is based by the AUAS on currently known information. If new information gives reason to change your tuition fee amount the AUAS reserves the right to do so. If your situation gives reason to determine a new tuition fee amount, you will receive a notification.

If the tuition fee cannot be collected or if payments are overdue, the enrolment may be refused or revoked as provided for in Article 4.5 of the Student Charter, or terminated as provided for in Article 4.6 of the Student Charter. You can find the Charter at: amsterdamuas.com/student-charter. In that case, you can no longer attend classes, take exams or be awarded a certificate. You will also be liable to pay any collection costs. Note: this does not mean that the tuition fee no longer needs to be paid.

The following conditions apply when using a money transfer authorisation to pay the tuition fee:

- You must ensure your bank balance is sufficient to cover the payment.
- Only European bank accounts from the SEPA area can be used. If you need more information, look at https://wiki.xmldata.com/Support/EPC/List_of_SEPA_countries
- You cannot use a blocked account for debt collection.
- You cannot reverse an instalment payment. If you do not agree with the direct debit transfers, you may contact the AUAS
- The authorisation cannot be cancelled prematurely.
- The costs of an Incorrect Direct Debit Report are for the account of the person who authorised the AUAS.
- You may not prematurely close the bank account.
- In the event the direct debit transfer of an instalment fails, that instalment will be deducted simultaneously with the subsequent instalment.
