

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Make sure you are well insured (luggage & health care) during your entire stay in the Netherlands. This is mandatory for all international students. Check with your health insurance company whether you have coverage in the Netherlands. If this is not the case, please arrange a new health insurance as soon as possible. - Make sure you know how to get in contact with your family/relatives in your home country.
- Inform the International Office of your AUAS Faculty about any change of address.
- Keep the contact details of the nearest embassy or consulate of your home country.
- Make copies of all official documents and keep them in another (safe) place than the originals. Also make a digital scan and send this to your e-mail address.
- Always inform the International Office of your AUAS Faculty that you are safe when you know that a (natural) disaster has taken place in (or near) your temporary place of residence.
- Carry important medical information (like your blood type) or medication with you.
- Always have your passport, ID-card or driver's license with you. This is mandatory in the Netherlands.
