#### Dear student,

It is possible that you have obtained or will obtain fewer credits than planned this year. This might be due to your personal circumstances, such as a disability or illness. Other reasons like lack of motivation might also throw a spanner in the works. If this applies to you, be sure to talk to a student counsellor without delay. Talking to a student counsellor could also be refreshing and useful if you are unsure that you will be able to obtain sufficient credits. Student counsellors provide support to a large number of students with a variety of problems and help out where they can. Having a chat with them could prevent you from falling behind in your studies.

## When does a (positive) binding study advice apply?

If you obtain 50\* or more credits during the first year of your studies, you will receive a positive binding study advice (BSA). If you do not, you may receive a negative BSA. You will also receive a negative BSA if you drop out during the academic year. A negative BSA means that you will not be readmitted to the same degree programme or a related programme. The same applies to degree programmes with a joint first-year programme.

### Was your study advice postponed?

If your study advice was postponed in the previous year of your studies, you will receive a BSA at the end of the second year of enrolment. If you have successfully completed your propaedeutic year examination by then, you will receive a positive BSA. If you have not, you may receive a negative BSA. Students who suspended their studies and were readmitted to the same degree programme this year due to a postponement of their study advice may also receive a negative BSA.

#### What can a student counsellor do for you?

- The student counsellor makes an inventory of the extent to which personal problems are currently influencing or are likely to influence your studies and advises on coping with these problems in relation to your studies.
- The student counsellor also gives advice on the support options available within and outside the AUAS.
- In addition, the student counsellor discusses with you which support schemes you might qualify for, e.g. test facilities (such as additional time) or financial support.
- The student counsellor can issue an advice to the examination board if you have obtained
  insufficient credits and are in danger of receiving a negative BSA due to a disability, illness,
  family circumstances, other extenuating circumstances, administrative duties or if you are an
  (upcoming) elite athlete. However, they can only do this if you inform them of your
  circumstances as soon as they arise.

In any event, even when in doubt, it is important that you do not delay and contact a student counsellor as soon as you can.
