



Embedding publication or database in Brightspace in a nutshell






Adding a book, article, chapter or journal








This is what the student will see.

- Digitally available publications can be opened directly from the catalogue, for printed publications the exact location is shown.
- Books and journals always display 'Check availability', even if the material is available digitally.
- Articles always show 'Available Online'.

If you embed a publication this way, no further reference to the source is necessary.
