



Permission form for publication of thesis in the HBO Kennisbank

The AUAS Library aims, subject to appropriate permission, to make theses that have been graded 7 or higher available on the HBO Kennisbank (HBO Knowledge Base). The purpose of this form is to determine whether publication is permitted and here we request your permission for this. Publication has no influence on the copyright, which remains with you as author. You can always withdraw your permission for publication at a later date by informing the Library. Your thesis will then be removed from the HBO Kennisbank.

If there are important reasons for doing so (for instance an infringement of copyright) the Library may withdraw your thesis from publication.

As an author, you have the freedom to choose which information to publish. Keep in mind that a published thesis is freely accessible and searchable through search engines such as Google. If you do not wish to publish personal information such as your phone number or student number online, be sure to remove them. If you would like to include your email address in your thesis, please note that your AUAS email address will no longer be available some time after you graduate.

1. Permission for publication

Do you give permission for publication?

N.B.: You can always withdraw your permission for publication at a later date. Your thesis will then be removed from the HBO Kennisbank.

2. Copyright

When writing your thesis you must respect the copyright of other parties. Among other things, this means correctly citing your sources and getting permission for any use of (visual) material, for instance in the form of a Creative Commons licence.

3. Personal and company data

If your thesis contains personal data or non-public company information, you may only publish these with explicit permission from the involved persons or companies (and internship-hosting organisation/client, if this exists). Sometimes they may give permission for company data to be made public after a specified embargo period. You can indicate this under 5. Embargo.

Permission is not required if personal data is anonymised so that it can no longer be linked to specific parties.

- My thesis is free of personal and company data, and hence no permission is required for publication.
- My thesis contains personal or company data for which permission for publication has not been obtained. *(thesis will not be published. Go to 9. Signature.)*



4. Publication-suitable version

It is possible to submit a version of your thesis that is suitable for publication.

Here you should consider the previously answered questions regarding copyright, personal data, sensitive company data and your own contact data. State on the title page that this is an amended / publication-suitable version.

- The definitive version of my thesis is suitable for publication
- I will submit a separate publication-suitable version of my thesis

5. Date of publication

State the period for which you wish to have your thesis published: 7 years or for an unlimited period.

Irrespective of your choice, you can withdraw your permission for publication at any time, after which your thesis will be removed from the HBO Kennisbank.

6. Embargo

Is your thesis subject to an embargo?

If you enter Yes, this means that your thesis can only be published at a specified time after you submit it, for instance because it uses company data that should not be made public until a later date.

7. Abstract

Here you should enter an abstract (brief summary) of your thesis. Use 150 to 250 words. This will be displayed on publication of your thesis.

The CC BY licence is the most frequently used option: in addition to reading, sharing and editing it also permits commercial use. You can also choose a variant that excludes commercial use. Whatever licence you choose, you retain the copyright: you can always reuse your thesis, including for commercial purposes.
