## Kate Raworth is Appointed as Professor of Practice

[Raworth](#) is a global opinion leader on the topic of sustainability and the importance of connecting ecological challenges with inclusivity. In her book, *Doughnut Economics*, she sketches a framework for this. Starting in January 2020, Raworth will be the content lead on a project that will see the AUAS concretise the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) in Amsterdam.
