STUDYLOAD

For modules 1 to 4;

- ▶ Preparatory work: 56 hours over two weeks, in home country
- ▶ Class work: 80 hours over two weeks, at hosting institution
- ▶ Assignment: 200 hours over 8 weeks, in home country

Module 5 and 6 have a different structure with more self-study with online support, leading to a research thesis.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

For this master's degree programme you will need:

- ▶ A Bachelor of Science in Occupational Therapy.
- ▶ English test: Overall band score of at least 6.5 for the **academic** IELTS-test (International English Language Testing Service) or equivalent
