an industrial and mining region?**

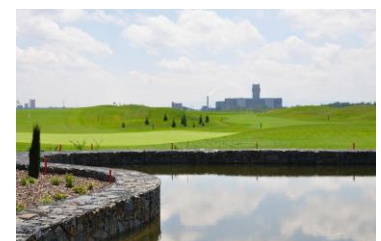

Become part of an international student team and try to find and propose solutions that would modify the social situation in localities with social needs. Try to find urban-architectonic solutions for the transformation of the territory with emphasis on mitigating the effects of climate change. Think about some technical issues that can be applicable to construction in any city in the world. In the context of the urban commons, try to identify the economic opportunities for people to participate in this transformation.



Explore new places - Ostrava and the whole region is a place to see. As part of the BIP Erasmus programme you will have the opportunity to meet people from the region called "Quirky region" and visit interesting and unique places.
